The Indonesian Ministry of Trade is tasked with issuing import and export licenses and checking goods post-border. Currently the Ministry does not apply a selectivity approach in these processes.

THE PROJECT OBJECTIVE

Developing a holistic approach to risk management and contribute to implementing the Indonesia Single Risk Management Strategy.

OUR SOLUTION

Developing systematic risk indicators for issuing import and export licenses and controlling goods post-border after customs release.

YOUR BENEFIT

The risk management scheme will result in less interventions, reward compliant traders and increase the overall level of compliance, leading to a reduction of the import documentation processing time for compliant traders.
